

Emergency paediatric drugs supplied to Phebe Hospital for training support.

- Adrenaline
- Prednisolone
- ReSoMal for dehydration in patients with malnutrition
- Oral Rehydration Salts (ORS)
- Vitamin A
- Intravenous paracetamol and Tramadol for pain control
- Intravenous Ampicillin, Gentamicin, Ceftriaxone and Metronidazole
- Hydrocortisone
- Dextrose 50%
- Intravenous fluid for resuscitation (Ringer Lactate or 0.9% saline)
- IV Artesunate
- Diazepam (PR or IV)
- Salbutamol inhalers and nebulisers for nebuliser

These drugs covered the majority of emergency admissions: severe malaria, sepsis, seizures, hypoglycaemia and shock, severe asthma, sickle cell crises.
